



## Advanced VASER<sup>®</sup> training course

The VASER<sup>®</sup> advanced training course is aimed at the experienced VASER<sup>®</sup> user (50-100 cases) and covers a range of topics including anatomy, adipose tissue, patient selection, consenting, advanced treatment techniques, recognising, reducing and managing complications, and thereby helping the doctor to maximise the aesthetic outcome of this treatment. It also focuses on setting realistic patient expectations and helping the doctor achieve realistic results.

The course covers the following;

- A further look at adipose cell structure, its physiology and biochemistry
- A review of important relevant anatomy such as the skin, superficial, middle and deep fat layers, fascia, muscle, ligaments, relevant neurovascular structures.
- Discussing common complications, such as infections, seromas irregularities, scars and scar retraction, burns, and general poor aesthetic outcome, what to look out for, ways to help avoid these, how these can be managed.
- Patient selection- “Avoiding pitfalls” understanding who is suitable and more importantly who is not suitable for this treatment, examining the absolute contra-indications and relative contra-indications, red flag treatments areas, consent and agreeing/setting treatment expectations
- Tumescence- exploring the different strengths of tumescence, various additives, recognising toxic effects of tumescence overdose, managing such events
- Pre treatment medication, pros and cons of IV sedation, benzodiazepines, analgesics etc
- Patient positioning for various treatment areas, optimal combination of various treatment areas
- Advanced treatments techniques including: managing operative pain/patient anxiety, placement of access points, minimising scarring, placement of tumescence, correct use of vaser probes, vaser settings, and suction cannulas, exploring positive and negative spaces, appreciating important aesthetic anatomical landmarks, suture techniques. Introduction to fat grafting for treatment of contour irregularities.
- Post treatment care- examining ways of reducing common complications, i.e. use of open drainage, use of surgical drains, compression garments and inserts, use of anti inflammatory medication, use of manual lymphatic drainage, antibiotics, sterile technique, etc.

The advanced VASER<sup>®</sup> treatment course is a day event run by Dr Dennis Wolf and Dr Mike Comins, encompassing lectures and interactive workshops, but focusing mainly on hands on patients’ treatments. We aim to cover various treatment areas in these sessions.

The course fees are £750.00 per candidate for BACD members (at least one year membership) and £3000.00 per candidate for non-BACD members.
